HICKSON, "HEALER," IN ROME

Scores Submit Themselves to His Ministrations at American Church.

ROME, May 15 – "Rome is excited over miracles" reported to be occurring in the American Church. All the Protestant churches of all languages were invited to services today for "a day of healing." James Moore Hickson, an Englishman, who some months ago carried on a faith healing mission in Paris, similar to that held in the United States in 1919, preached and then invited all the sick, crippled and blind to the altar to be healed. Those unable to walk Hickson assisted. All engaged in prayer, and Hickson then touched them. Some declared they had been benefited. Hickson says he heals by making the sick have faith that God will heal them. There were many Italians among the sick.
