Evangelist Says Miracles Still Possible

Raymond T. Richey, well-known evangelist now conducting a series of meetings at the Full Gospel Tabernacle, 915 Massachusetts Avenue Northwest, in a message this week took issue with "modernists who contend that the day of great emotional soul-stirring revivals is over."

He said he had seen as great and spectacular revivals in the last two years as at any time in his ministry, during which time he said that more than 700,000 persons have made Christian decisions. "God will work" he said, "when men will pay the price. The day of miracles is not past for the man or woman who will believe God."
