Hicks Speaking at the Voice of Healing Convention June 1958

The closing service, Sunday afternoon, had arrived. Tommy Hicks, to whom God gave the greatest revival in recorded history in Argentina, preached with real fervency from Romans 10:9, 10, "Thou shalt be delivered (saved)." The message of "Christ in me, the hope of glory," is what is going to release multitudes. It's not preaching against false religions, but preaching Christ. I never waste my time preaching against false religions when I go to a foreign country. I just preach Christ. Exodus 15:26 says, "I'm the Lord thy God. I'm healing you right now." "These signs shall follow them that go through Bible School." Is that right? The Word says, "These signs shall follow them that believe."

In Africa Brother Hicks saw a native boy who had just heard this message. He went over to a crippled lady and began to say, "Get up, get up," as he kept slapping her on the cheeks. "The preacher said that if I believe, you'll be healed, and I believe." In just a moment, the woman arose and was well. This boy couldn't read or write, he didn't even know who his father or mother were, but he believed and began praying for the sick, the blind, the lame, and they were gloriously healed. God wants to enlist you today. Hundreds were prayed for by Brother Hicks for healing. Faith was high and it was easy to touch God.
